



FOUNDATION EDUCATION AWARD SCHOLARSHIP

2020-2021 Academic Year Award

A \$2,276 scholarship will be awarded to two qualified underrepresented minority medical students.

Eligibility for scholarship applicants:

- Applicant must be a United States citizen.
- Applicant must be a Pennsylvania resident for at least 12 months prior to registering as a medical student (not including time spent attending an undergraduate or graduate school).
- Applicant must be of the following racial/ethnic groups:
 - African American/Black
 - Hispanic/Latino
 - Native American (American Indian / Alaskan Native / Native Hawaiian)
 - Southeast Asian subgroup (Vietnamese / Cambodian / Indonesian / Laotian).
- Applicant must be enrolled full time in an accredited Pennsylvania medical school.
- Applicant may receive a maximum of two scholarship awards.

Applicant must use the [Scholarship Application Portal](#) to submit the following:

1. A completed scholarship application form.
2. Two reference letters, from persons other than family members, documenting the applicant's integrity, interpersonal skills, and potential as a future physician. **Note: One reference letter must be from a physician or medical school faculty.**
3. A letter, on school letterhead, from the applicant's medical school verifying that he/she is enrolled as a full-time medical student at that institution.
4. An essay describing **the person or event that most influenced you to become a physician and how you see yourself leading others into medicine.** (500 words or less)

Online applications open July 1 at <https://applications.foundationpamedsoc.org/scholarships/>.

Application must be submitted by September 30 of the current year.

Applicants will be notified of the committee's decision in December of the current year.
